Meeting Topic: Mount Haggin Wildlife Management Area Restoration

Presentation by: Pedro Marques, Big Hole Watershed Committee

Background: Pedro will discuss restoration progress on the Mount Haggin Wildlife Management Area, where we recently completed the restoration of California Creek as well as finishing construction on the French Gulch and Moose Creek restoration project. Pedro's presentation will focus on low-tech and high-tech restoration tools for erosion control and re-building of highly degraded landscapes. He'll be showing results in terms of sediment capture, floodplain connectivity, and vegetation establishment on degraded high slopes and incised headwaters tributaries.
